
#### IN-PERSOISCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Parents are to confirm with theirschool Principals by June 4.

### DELIVERY MODEL (CONVENTICONAD mester")

The Ministry of Education has announced thating specific safety measures as well as limiting the amount of student contacts will allow secondary students to return to school September. The following message are key to the respening of SGDS shools

- 9 Normal school day routine with enhand public healthprotocols(see Fact Sheets including PE, Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette, Physical Distancing, etc.
- 9 All high school students and staff will be required to wear masks (to cover nose and mouth) indoors on school property
- 9 Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette routines will be established in all schools, upon entry, before lunch, before and after using threashroom, etc.
- 9 Timetables will limit the number of firect and indirect student contacts to approximatelly 0 students in the school
- 9 Schools will have semestes in the year where students will take 2 courses per day.
- 9 Students will have 1 course for 50 minutes in the morning and 1 course for 150 minutes in the afternoon.



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
#### **TRAINING**
