- iv. Improvement in learning outcomes for all students; develop the skills needed for all students to be positive leaders and self-directed life-long learners.
- v. The fair treatment of others, regardless of their race, ancestry, place of origin, ethnicity, colour, citizenship, religion/creed, gender expression, gender identity, sexual orientation, family status, marital status, or age, sex, ability and/or any other immutable characteristic or ground protected by the Human Rights Code is an expectation from all school members. Not swear at a teacher or at another person in a position of authority, Decreptoresponsibility for own actions and Demonstrate respect through appropriate known to cause) fear and distress and/or harm to another body, feelings, self-esteem, or reputation. Bullying occurs in a context where there is a real or perceived power imbalance.

Students may attain or maintain power over others in the school through real or perceived differences. Some areas of difference may be size, strength, age, intelligence, economic status, social status, solidarity of peer group, religion, ethnicity, ability, need for special education, sexual orientation, family circumstances, gender, and race.
